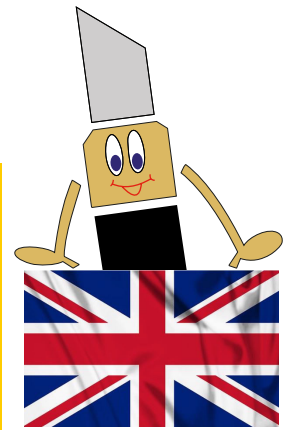


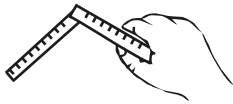


The film/vinyl **CAN NOT** be rolled opposite to the way the vinyl is rolled upon receipt. To get the film/vinyl straightened before mounting, you place it on a flat surface, approx. 1 day before mounting.



WHEN YOU INSTALL: WHITEBOARD / IRON FILM / VINYL :

ONLY To be used on surfaces intended for water!



1. Measure where the foil is to be mounted.

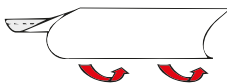


2. Then clean the surface **THOROUGHLY** before mounting (mounting the liquid can be used advantageously) **THIS IS VERY IMPORTANT SINCE DUST, DIRT OR GREASE RESIDUES MAY PREVENT THE FILM/VINYL FROM ADHERING PROPERLY.**



MOUNTING FLUID RECIPE
1/2 liter of water
1/2 tsp. dishwashing liquid.

3. Atomize the mounting fluid in an even layer, on the cleaned surface where the vinyl will be mounted.



4. The back paper is removed. (From here it can be an advantage being 2 persons to handle larger pieces)

- Wrap the included scraper in a cloth to reduce scratches on the vinyl.



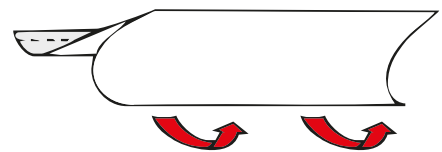
5. The film/vinyl is now mounted according to your measurements on the surface. Scratch a in figure of a cross, Scratch from center to left, Scrape from center to right, Scrape from center up, Scrape from center to bottom. **TAKE ONE SQUARE AT A TIME, REMEMBER TO START FROM THE CENTER OF THE CROSS AND PRESS ALL THE WATER OUT TOWARDS THE EDGE OF THE FOIL. SCRAPE WELL TO MAKE SURE THE WATER IS COMPLETELY OUT**

Dry mounting on a wall/other that does NOT tolerate water.

- Wrap the included scraper in a cloth to reduce scratches on the vinyl.



1. Measure where the film/vinyl is to be mounted. If necessary, set up masking tape to mark where the vinyl should be mounted.



2. Remove about 10cm of the back paper, which you bend over and flatten with a fingernail. (From here it can be an advantage to be 2 persons to handle larger pieces) scrape from the start of the vinyl and from the middle out. Then remove the back paper little by little. And scrape all the continuously from where it is attached, always scrape from the middle out on the piece where you have removed the baking paper. **Repeat until you are finished.**
